

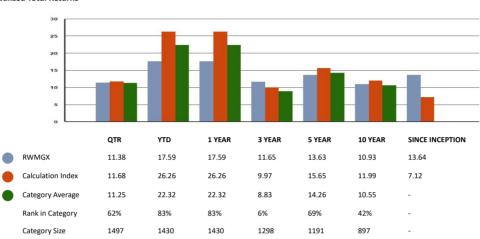
American Funds Washington Mutual R6 (RWMGX)

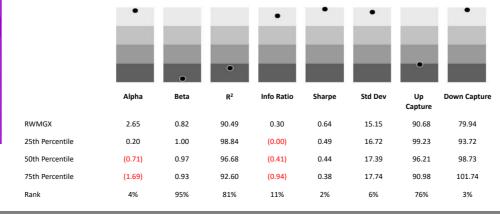

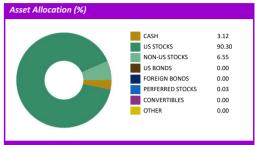
